
10. Organizational chart:

A quality circle on guidance and counseling is functioning in the college with 10 members comprising of students and staff. Separate Internal counselor for each department have been duly appointed as per the request from the quality circle members to whom the students approach for counseling and guidance whenever need arises.

Career Counseling:

The "Placement & Career Development Cell" comprises a representative from each department. It is headed by a separate Placement officer in the grade of Professor with independent charge. The Cell meets every 3 months and draws plans for preparing the students for placement and placement plans. The Cell invites senior executives involved in placement interviews to visit the college and share their views, experiences and their expectations, to enable the students to prepare for their future placement interviews.

The committee invites recruiting corporate companies and a set of bio-data of eligible students is given to them. Students are also given a brief introduction about the visiting company for campus interview.

Medical facilities:

The College Medical Centre caters boys, girls, workers and staff. The full time Resident Medical Officer is assisted by a full time qualified staff nurse and a qualified pharmacist. Later is in charge of the pharmacy. There are 2 single-bedded rooms in addition to one treatment room. It renders round the clock service; Attends all emergencies and gives all first-aid care.

Institution of Engineers one of the biggest engineering associations in India formed an engineering student wing which is presently having 1000 branches throughout the country. The branch of the student wing is inaugurated in 21-12-2012 in Nadar Saraswathi Engineering College, Theni and presently the chapter function effectively by conducting various events every week.

The aims and objectives, for which the IEI is constituted, are to promote the general advancement of Engineering and Engineering Science and their applications and to facilitate the exchange of information and ideas on these subjects, amongst the members and the persons attached to the Institution.

This chapter is conducting some technical sessions every week in order to improve the technical excellence of the students. This includes Invited Guest Lecture, Site Visits, and Technical Competitions such as Technical Quiz, Technical Cross Words, Technical Dump Charades, Technical paper presentations, Students presentation & Faculty Lectures. Other than this, the chapter is conducting some competitions for the entire students of the college in order to make their inherent capability of students in a more effective way.

d. Computer Society of India:
